The Seals, Vials, and Trumpets
Recorded: May 2, 2010

The First Seal is a description of the Multitude and what they do during the Tribulation.

Add-Revelation 6:1.2

And when he had opened the second seal, I heard the second beast say, Come and see. [4] And there went out another horse that was red: and power was given to him that sat thereon to take peace from the earth, and that they should kill one another: and there was given unto him a great sword. *Revelation 6:3, 4*

The Second Seal is a description of the Serpents and what they do during the Tribulation.

And when he had opened the third seal, I heard the third beast say, Come and see. And I beheld, and lo a black horse; and he that sat on him had a pair of balances in his hand. [6] And I heard a voice in the midst of the four beasts say, A measure of wheat for a penny, and three measures of barley for a penny; and see thou hurt not the oil and the wine. *Revelation 6:5, 6*

The Third Seal is a description of the Scorpions and what they do during the Tribulation.

And when he had opened the fourth seal, I heard the voice of the fourth beast say, Come and see. [8] And I looked, and behold a pale horse: and his name that sat on him was Death, and Hell followed with him. And power was given unto them over the fourth part of the earth, to kill with sword, and with hunger, and with death, and with the beasts of the earth. Revelation 6:7, 8

The Fourth Seal is a description of the combination of the Serpents and the Scorpions.

And when he had opened the fifth seal, I saw under the altar the souls of them that were slain for the word of God, and for the testimony which they held: [10] And they cried with a loud voice, saying, How long, O Lord, holy and true, dost thou not judge and avenge our blood on them that dwell on the earth? [11] And white robes were given unto every one of them; and it was said unto them, that they should rest yet for a little season, until their fellowservants also and their brethren, that should be killed as they were, should be fulfilled. Revelation 6:9-11

The Fifth Seal is a statement describing that the Multitude will be waking up and will be killed.

And I beheld when he had opened the sixth seal, and, lo, there was a great earthquake; and the sun became black as sackcloth of hair, and the moon became as blood; [13] And the stars of heaven fell unto the earth, even as a fig tree casteth her untimely figs, when she is shaken of a mighty wind. [14] And the heaven departed as a scroll when it is rolled together; and every mountain and island were moved out of their places. [15] And the kings of the earth, and the great men, and the rich men, and the chief captains, and the mighty men, and every bondman, and every free man, hid themselves in the dens and in the rocks of the mountains; [16] And said to the mountains and rocks, Fall on us, and hide us from the face of him that sitteth on the throne, and from the wrath of the Lamb: [17] For the great day of his wrath is come; and who shall be able to stand? Revelation 6:12-17

The Sixth Seal is an overview of what occurs during the Tribulation. The earthquake is another word used for the Tribulation. The sun becoming black is speaking about the Scorpions. The moon is speaking about the Multitude. The stars are speaking about the Serpents. The running into the dens and rocks is speaking about the Multitude trying to hide from the wrath of the Lord. They will wise up and become that white horse of the 1st Seal.

And when he had opened the seventh seal, there was silence in heaven about the space of half an hour. Revelation 8:1

The Seventh Seal is a description of the killing of the Multitude (silence) over the period of the Tribulation. The reference to the half hour is a reference to the last half of the seventieth week of Daniel.

The Vials

And after that I looked, and, behold, the temple of the tabernacle of the testimony in heaven was opened: [6] And the seven angels came out of the temple, having the seven plagues, clothed in pure and white linen, and having their breasts girded with golden girdles. [7] And one of the four beasts gave unto the seven angels seven golden vials full of the wrath of God, who liveth for ever and ever. [8] And the temple was filled with smoke from the glory of God, and from his power; and no man was able to enter into the temple, till the seven plagues of the seven angels were fulfilled. *Revelation 15:5-8*

The Seven Vials are ready to be poured and no man may enter into the temple until the Seven Vials are completed. This is a reference to the Multitude (no man) [the first beast of Daniel (was made to stand upon its feet as a man)] and the dead in Christ rising. When they rise at the Seventh Trumpet they will enter into the temple and serve God day and night. This cannot occur until the Seven Vials are completed.

And I heard a great voice out of the temple saying to the seven angels, Go your ways, and pour out the vials of the wrath of God upon the earth. [2] And the first went, and poured out his vial upon the earth; and there fell a noisome and grievous sore upon the men which had the mark of the beast, and upon them which worshipped his image. *Revelation 16:1, 2*

The First Vial is describing the marking of the Serpents and the Scorpions and this now sets them on their paths.

And the second angel poured out his vial upon the sea; and it became as the blood of a dead man: and every living soul died in the sea. *Revelation 16:3*

The Second Vial is a description of the killing of the Multitude.

[4] And the third angel poured out his vial upon the rivers and fountains of waters; and they became blood. *Revelation 16:4*

The Third Vial is a description of the killing of the Multitude.

And the fourth angel poured out his vial upon the sun; and power was given unto him to scorch men with fire. [9] And men were scorched with great heat, and blasphemed the name of God, which hath power over these plagues: and they repented not to give him glory. *Revelation 16:8, 9*

The Fourth Vial is a description of the Multitude being killed and the ones that do the killing (Serpents) blaspheme God by their actions of killing the Multitude.

And the fifth angel poured out his vial upon the seat of the beast; and his kingdom was full of darkness; and they gnawed their tongues for pain, [11] And blasphemed the God of heaven because of their pains and their sores, and repented not of their deeds. Revelation 16:10, 11

The Fifth Seal is describing the darkness that envelopes the Scorpions and the Serpents, i.e. evil spirits deceiving them and no truth in them. Gnawing their tongues for pain and the pains and sores is a description of the work that they are diligently accomplishing in the capture and the killing of the Multitude. In doing so, they are blaspheming God through this process.

And the sixth angel poured out his vial upon the great river Euphrates; and the water thereof was dried up, that the way of the kings of the east might be prepared. [13] And I saw three unclean spirits like frogs come out of the mouth of the dragon, and out of the mouth of the beast, and out of the mouth of the false prophet. [14] For they are the spirits of devils, working miracles, which go forth unto the kings of the earth and of the whole world, to gather them to the battle of that great day of God Almighty. [15] Behold, I come as a thief. Blessed is he that watcheth, and keepeth his garments, lest he walk naked, and they see his shame. [16] And he gathered them together into a place called in the Hebrew tongue Armageddon. Revelation 16:12-16

The Sixth Vial is speaking about the coming of the Serpents (kings of the east) and the three frogs represents the false doctrines that drive the Serpents to do what they do. These three doctrines are most likely 1. The Rapture Doctrine, 2. Dispensationalism, 3. Zionism. This includes a warning to the Multitude that the Lord is coming. The gathering together for the battle of Armageddon is the marching orders given to the Serpents and the Scorpions to proceed with their tasks.

And the seventh angel poured out his vial into the air; and there came a great voice out of the temple of heaven, from the throne, saying, It is done. [18] And there were voices, and thunders, and lightnings; and there was a great earthquake, such as was not since men were upon the earth, so mighty an earthquake, and so great. [19] And the great city was divided into three parts, and the cities of the nations fell: and great Babylon came in remembrance before God, to give unto her the cup of the wine of the fierceness of his wrath. [20] And every island fled away, and the mountains were not found. [21] And there fell upon men a great hail out of heaven, every stone about the weight of a talent: and men blasphemed God because of the plague of the hail; for the plague thereof was exceeding great. Revelation 16:17-21

The Seventh Vial is describing the division of the Babylon, the separation of the tares and their being marked, and the hail of the 1st Trumpet (Serpents) coming down on the Multitude. The earthquake of the Seventh Vial is the same earthquake of the 6th Seal.

The Trumpets

The first angel sounded, and there followed hail and fire mingled with blood, and they were cast upon the earth: and the third part of trees was burnt up, and all green grass was burnt up. Revelation 8:7

The First Trumpet is describing the division of Babylon into the Serpents (hail), the Scorpions (fire), and the Multitude (mingled with blood). The killing of the Multitude (trees being burned up) and the stripping of the goods of the Multitude (green grass burnt up).

And the second angel sounded, and as it were a great mountain burning with fire was cast into the sea: and the third part of the sea became blood; [9] And the third part of the creatures which were in the sea, and had life, died; and the third part of the ships were destroyed. Revelation 8:8, 9

The Second Trumpet is describing the judgement of Babylon, the killing of the Multitude (sea became blood, 1/3 creatures that had life died, 1/3 of the ships destroyed.)

And the third angel sounded, and there fell a great star from heaven, burning as it were a lamp, and it fell upon the third part of the rivers, and upon the fountains of waters; [11] And the name of the star is called Wormwood: and the third part of the waters became wormwood; and many men died of the waters, because they were made bitter. Revelation 8:10, 11

The Third Trumpet is describing the Serpents killing the Multitude and the bitterness that they have to endure through their trials.

And the fourth angel sounded, and the third part of the sun was smitten, and the third part of the moon, and the third part of the stars; so as the third part of them was darkened, and the day shone not for a third part of it, and the night likewise. Revelation 8:12

The Fourth Trumpet is describing the transformation that takes place with the Scorpions (sun) the Multitude (moon) and the Serpents (stars). The darkening of the third part is the marking of the Serpents and the Scorpions and the killing of the Multitude.

And I beheld, and heard an angel flying through the midst of heaven, saying with a loud voice, Woe, woe, woe, to the inhabitants of the earth by reason of the other voices of the trumpet of the three angels, which are yet to sound! Revelation 8:13

The Three Woes

And the fifth angel sounded, and I saw a star fall from heaven unto the earth: and to him was given the key of the bottomless pit. [2] And he opened the bottomless pit; and there arose a smoke out of the pit, as the smoke of a great furnace; and the sun and the air were darkened by reason of the smoke of the pit. [3] And there came out of the smoke locusts

upon the earth: and unto them was given power, as the scorpions of the earth have power. [4] And it was commanded them that they should not hurt the grass of the earth, neither any green thing, neither any tree; but only those men which have not the seal of God in their foreheads.

5 And to them it was given that they should not kill them, but that they should be tormented five months: and their torment was as the torment of a scorpion, when he striketh a man. [6] And in those days shall men seek death, and shall not find it; and shall desire to die, and death shall flee from them. [7] And the shapes of the locusts were like unto horses prepared unto battle; and on their heads were as it were crowns like gold, and their faces were as the faces of men. [8] And they had hair as the hair of women, and their teeth were as the teeth of lions. [9] And they had breastplates, as it were breastplates of iron; and the sound of their wings was as the sound of chariots of many horses running to battle. [10] And they had tails like unto scorpions, and there were stings in their tails: and their power was to hurt men five months. [11] And they had a king over them, which is the angel of the bottomless pit, whose name in the Hebrew tongue is Abaddon, but in the Greek tongue hath his name Apollyon. *Revelation 9:1-11*

The Fifth Trumpet is a detailed description of the Scorpions, the powers that they have and the acts that they do.

One woe is past; and, behold, there come two woes more hereafter. *Revelation 9:12*

And the sixth angel sounded, and I heard a voice from the four horns of the golden altar which is before God, [14] Saying to the sixth angel which had the trumpet, Loose the four angels which are bound in the great river Euphrates.

[15] And the four angels were loosed, which were prepared for an hour, and a day, and a month, and a year, for to slay the third part of men. [16] And the number of the army of the horsemen were two hundred thousand thousand: and I heard the number of them. [17] And thus I saw the horses in the vision, and them that sat on them, having breastplates of fire, and of jacinth, and brimstone: and the heads of the horses were as the heads of lions; and out of their mouths issued fire and smoke and brimstone. [18] By these three was the third part of men killed, by the fire, and by the smoke, and by the brimstone, which issued out of their mouths. [19] For their power is in their mouth, and in their tails: for their tails were like unto serpents, and had heads, and with them they do hurt. [20] And the rest of the men which were not killed by these plagues yet repented not of the works of their hands, that they should not worship devils, and idols of gold, and silver, and brass, and stone, and of wood: which neither can see, nor hear, nor walk: [21] Neither repented they of their murders, nor of their sorceries, nor of their fornication, nor of their thefts. *Revelation 9:13-21*

The Sixth Trumpet is a description of the Serpents, the power that they have and what they do.

And the seventh angel sounded; and there were great voices in heaven, saying, The kingdoms of this world are become the kingdoms of our Lord, and of his Christ; and he

shall reign for ever and ever. [16] And the four and twenty elders, which sat before God on their seats, fell upon their faces, and worshipped God,

[17] Saying, We give thee thanks, O Lord God Almighty, which art, and wast, and art to come; because thou hast taken to thee thy great power, and hast reigned.

[18] And the nations were angry, and thy wrath is come, and the time of the dead, that they should be judged, and that thou shouldest give reward unto thy servants the prophets, and to the saints, and them that fear thy name, small and great; and shouldest destroy them which destroy the earth. [19] And the temple of God was opened in heaven, and there was seen in his temple the ark of his testament: and there were lightnings, and voices, and thunderings, and an earthquake, and great hail. *Revelation 11:15-19*
